HUNTER DIVISION 1, 3, 4, 5 - \$32 to enter all classes in division.

YOUTH ENGLISH DIVISION 16, 17, 22, 23, 26, 27 - \$50 to enter all classes in division.

ADULT ENGLISH DIVISION 20, 21, 24, 25, 28, 29 - \$50 to enter all classes in division.

YOUTH WESTERN DIVISION 34, 35, 38, 39, 44, 45- \$50 to enter all classes in division.

ADULT WESTERN DIVISION 36, 37, 42, 43, 46, 47- \$50 to enter all classes in division

RANCH HORSE DIVISION: 52,53,54,55,56 - \$42 to enter all classes in division

Show reserves the right to combine/cancel/split classes as warranted. English classes open to saddle seat, hunt seat, and dressage style riding. Gaited horses welcome.
